CAMConnect creates archive of Jan. 30 hearing

Also delivers testimony on municipal budget

The New Jersey State Legislature held a joint hearing on Camden on January 30 in Trenton. This hearing was required by law as part of the Municipal Rehabilitation and Economic Recovery Act (MRERA). CAMConnect has created an archive of testimony submitted at this event on its website, as well as an annotated link to the audio file on the Legislature's website.

In addition to hosting this archive of the hearing, CAMConnect submitted testimony to the legislature about trends in the City's structural deficit and the flawed process in which the municipal budget is established. This testimony builds on CAMConnect's earlier work in researching and explaining the Camden municipal budget

Including Audits, Consultant Reports, School Report Card

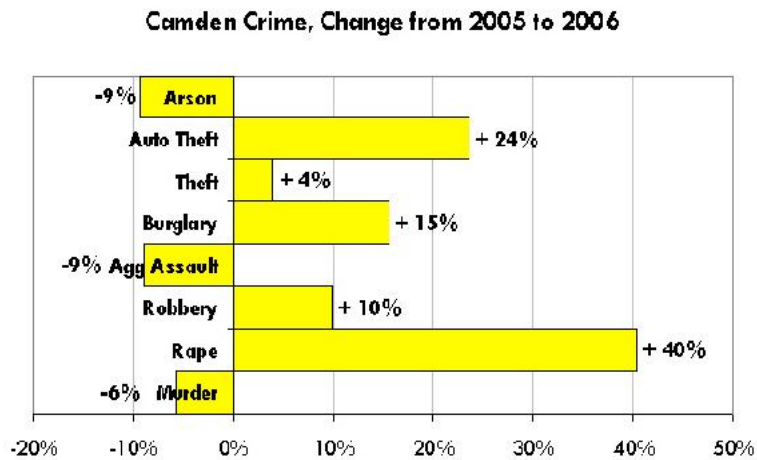
