Intervention Team-Camden Public School District*

Since Camden is an Abbott District, the Department of Education is authorized to:

- Work with Camden to increase the efficiency of school operations by maximizing spending on effective instructional practices.
- Assign a Local Support Team to Camden.
- Work with the central offices and School Leadership Councils to assure development of effective three-year operational plans and budgets.
- Review and approve budgets.
- Review and approve three-year operational plans.

AND

Because Camden Public Schools have been designated as a Level II district, the Department of Education is authorized to:

- Appoint an external review team to examine identified deficiencies in the Camden Public Schools and/or all aspects of the Camden Board of Education's operations such as education, management, governance and finance.
- Direct Camden to develop a corrective action plan to implement the recommendations.
- Review and approve the district's corrective action plan and determine the cost of implementing the plan.
- Review and approve the districts operating budget.
- Reallocate funds within the district's budget to support the corrective action plan.

AND

Because of the Camden Municipal Rehabilitation and Economic Recovery Act, the Department of Education assists the Governor's Office in the:

- Review of all Camden Board of Education minutes of meetings
- Makes recommendations to the Office of the Governor to accept, modify or reject actions presented in all Camden Board of Education minutes of meetings
- Provides guidance to the Board Secretary regarding procedural irregularities for follow-up by the district.
